

#### **PLAYER TO WATCH**





#### THE GAME

Oklahoma, playing at home for the first time in almost a month (last home game was Sept. 15), hosts Missouri in the Sooners' Homecoming game. OU topped rival Texas last Saturday at Dallas (28-21), while Missouri popped Nebraska in Columbia (41-6).

#### **THE SERIES**

Oklahoma leads it 63-23-5 count, including a 31-8-5 mark in Norman. The Sooners have won the last four meetings in the series and 16 of the last 17. OU won in Columbia last season (26-10) and also took the last contest between the two in Norman (34-13 in 2003).

#### **THE COACHES**

**Oklahoma:** Bob Stoops (Iowa '83) is 91-20 in his ninth season with the Sooners. He is 4-4 in bowls, 3-3 in January Bowls, 2-3 in BCS games, 57-12 vs. the Big 12, 32-8 vs. the Big 12 South, 25-4 vs. the Big 12 North, 4-1 in the Big 12 title game, 33-8 vs. non-conference opponents, 50-2 at home, 26-10 on the road, 14-8 on neutral fields and 26-10 vs. ranked foes. He is 4-0 vs. Missouri **Missouri:** Gary Pinkel (Kent St. '73) is 42-35 in his seventh year at MU, 115-72-3 in 17 years overall.

#### **THE PROGRAM**

■ Oklahoma's all-time record stands at 773-293-53. ■ The Sooners own seven national championships (1950, 1955, 1956, 1974, 1975, 1985, 2000). ■ OU has 40 bowl appearances (No. 7 nationally) with 24 victories (No. 3 nationally). ■ Oklahoma has won 40 conference titles. ■ Since WWII, Oklahoma is the most successful college football program with 529 victories. ■ Some 142 All-Americans and four Heisman Trophy winners have come from the Oklahoma program.

#### **WEEKLY MEDIA LUNCHEON**

Each Tuesday during the season OU hosts a media luncheon inside the Kerr McGee Stadium Club (east side) at Gaylord Family - Oklahoma Memorial Stadium. The luncheon begins at 11:15 a.m., with comments from the head coach of OU's opponent that week (by speaker phone if the coach is available). Lunch is served at 11:30 a.m., and OU head coach Bob Stoops steps to the podium at 12:05 p.m. A limited number of Sooner players are on hand for interviews.

#### **CREDENTIALS**

Requests for credentials are accepted online. To receive the link to the web site, e-mail Kenny Mossman at kmossman@ou.edu. Requests must be submitted by a sports director/editor at least eight days prior to the contest. Media attending games will have passes scanned and must show government issued photo identification upon entering the stadium. If the name on the credential and the photo ID do not match, the credential will be voided.

The University of Oklahoma Athletics Media Relations office has opened a media-only website to assist in covering Sooner sports. The site is valuable for reporters, but also to desk personnel needing stock photographs or similar support. For information on accessing the site, contact Kenny Mossman.

#### **PRACTICE**

All practice sessions are closed to media and public unless otherwise posted. On days when post-practice interviews are conducted, media should gather outside the practice site 10-15 minutes before the workout is complete. Requests for interviews will be recorded at that time and members of the athletics media relations staff will escort media into the practice facility at the appropriate time.

#### **INTERVIEWS**

All interview requests should be submitted to the OU Athletic Media Relations Office ...

- Head Coach Bob Stoops will do general interviews following practice on Monday. All other requests must be submitted to Kenny Mossman.
- Assistant Coaches: The coaches are available after the Monday-Wednesday practices (coordinators who appear at the Tuesday luncheon are not available that day).
- Players: All interviews with players will take place at the media luncheon or after practice on Monday and Tuesday. Media should request players at least 24 hours in advance. Those who attend the media luncheon are not available after Tuesday's practice.
- Post-Game: The OU locker room is closed at all times. Head coach Bob Stoops and several Sooner players will be brought to designated areas. After home games, the interview area is the Switzer Center's Red Room, located under the south end zone grandstand.

#### **ABOUT THE MATCH-UP**

- Oklahoma quarterback Sam Bradford leads the nation in pass efficiency (187.03), while Missouri's Chase Daniel is No. 3 in total offense (380.0).
- OU is No. 6 nationally in sacks (3.83), while Missouri is No. 13 in sacks allowed. The Sooners are No. 2 in sacks allowed, while Missouri is No. 46 in sacks.
- Missouri is No. 5 in total offense (556.6), while OU is No. 11 in total defense (283.8).

#### **LAST YEAR'S GAME**

No. 19 Oklahoma defeated No. 23 Missouri at Columbia, 26-10, on Oct. 28, 2006 ...

- OU converted four Missouri turnovers (three interceptions, one fumble) into 17 points.
- The Sooners rushed 52 times for 231 yards. Allen Patrick carried 25 times for 157.
- Missouri got 284 of its 360 total offense through the air on 23-of-46 passing by Daniel, who accounted for all but one of the Tigers' total yards.
- OU possessed the ball for 36:23, was penalized just five times and did not commit a turnover.

#### **OKLAHOMA'S MOST RECENT GAME**

For the sixth time in Bob Stoops' nine seasons, the Sooners defeated Texas at Dallas, 28-21 ...

- Sam Bradford completed 21-of-32 passes for 244 yards and three touchdowns with no interceptions. The Redshirt freshman hit nine in a row at one point.
- DeMarco Murray, also a redshirt frosh, rushed 17 times for 128 yards and one TD (65-yards).
- Juaquin Iglesias caught six passes for 99 yards, while Malcolm Kelly had five for 105 and one touchdown, the 20th of his career.
- TE Jermaine Gresham caught two touchdown passes to mark the eighth time a Sooner has recorded two or more six-pointers in a game this season.
- The Sooner defense was led by Nic Harris' eight tackles. Auston English logged a pair of sacks, while Reggie Smith had an interception and Curtis Lofton a forced fumble. Lofton's play came when he stripped Jamaal Charles inside the Sooner five yardline.
- For the first time this season Oklahoma did not commit a turnover.
- A crowd of 80,000 represented the 62nd consecutive sellout in the series.

#### **SOONERS DIGGING THE LONG BALL**

OU has 44 plays, offense and defense, of 20 yards or longer (not including special teams) ...

- Plays of 20-29 Yards -- Offense (17): 13 passes, four rushes. Defense (2): Two INT returns.
- Plays of 30-39 Yards -- Offense (6): Three passes, three rushes. Defense (2): Two INT returns.
- Plays of 40+ Yards -- Offense (15): 10 passes, five rushes. Defense (2): One INT, one FR. Notes: Four Sooners have a rush of 41 yards or longer ... OU has a 53-yard FG from Garrett Hartley ... OU's opponents have 16 plays (14 passes) of 20+ yards ... OU's longest play was a 92-yard TD run by DeMarco Murray vs. Utah State ... he also had an 81-yard KOR at Tulsa.

#### **MISCELLANY**

- ESPN College GameDay is in Norman. It will be the 14th time the show has been set at an Oklahoma game. GameDay's last visit to Norman was for the 2003 Oklahoma State game. Other trips to Norman included 2000 Nebraska, 2001 Kansas State and 1995 Colorado.
- Bob Stoops' teams are 8-0 in games immediately after the Red River Rivalry game vs. Texas.
- Oklahoma has had a 100-yard receiver in five of six games this season.
- DeMarco Murray and Allen Patrick both have 100-yard rushing games this season. It marks the fifth consecutive season that more than one tailback achieved the feat in the same year. Those two average 6.6 and 6.5 yards per carry, respectively.
- OU has four, one-play scoring drives. Three of those plays were rushes and the shortest, a rush, was 17 yards.
- OU has two, 90-yard scoring drives: 96 against Utah State and 94 against Texas.
- OU opponents are 24-of-94 on third down for 25.5%. OU is 35-of-75 for 46.7%.
- OU opponents have 22 more pass attempts than the Sooners with five fewer completions.
- OU ran between 69 and 73 (73 three times) plays in its five wins, 46 in its loss.
- Rushing -- OU 243 attempts for 1,297 yards (5.3/carry); opponents 211 for 399 (1.9/carry).
- Oklahoma has 10 turnovers as opposed to 14 by the opponents. OU scored 59 points (8 TD, 1 FG) off the turnovers, the opponents have 30 (3 TD, 3 FG).

#### THE SOONERS BRIEFLY

- Oklahoma was tabbed for a second-place finish in the Big 12's South Division in a preseason polling of league media. Defensive back Reggie Smith was named the league's preseason defensive player of the year.
- There are 34 players on this team with previous experience as a starter for OU. That's up from 10 over the number that returned last season.

#### **HOME FIELD HONCHOS**

- Oklahoma is 50-2 at Gaylord Family Oklahoma Memorial Stadium under Bob Stoops and has won its last 14 in a row there and 34 of its last 35. During Stoops's tenure, which included home winning streaks of 19 and 17 games, OU has registered six shutouts on Owen Field.
- The Sooners are 26-1 against the Big 12 at home under their current head coach and have won their last 17 conference games on Owen Field.

#### **GREAT SLATE**

- Oklahoma has played exclusive Football Bowl Subdivision (formerly I-A) opposition since Bob Stoops' opener in 1999 (a 49-0 win over I-AA Indiana State) or for 110 consecutive games. The entire 2007 schedule is comprised of FBS competition.
- Under Stoops, Oklahoma has played regular season games against Notre Dame, UCLA (twice), Alabama (twice), Oregon (twice), Miami, Louisville, North Carolina, Air Force and Washington. Future slates feature Miami, Washington, Tennessee, Notre Dame, LSU and Florida State.

#### **CLOSE SHAVES**

Oklahoma's loss at Colorado marked the fourth time in the last five Sooner setbacks that the game was decided on the game's final play: 2007 Colorado (CU field goal), 2007 Fiesta Bowl (Boise State TD), 2006 Oregon (blocked Oklahoma field goal attempt) and 2005 Texas Tech (TTU touchdown). Those four losses were by a total of seven points (27-24 at Colorado, 43-42 to Boise State, 34-33 at Oregon and 23-21 at Texas Tech), and all were away from Norman.

#### STOOPS ERA YIELDING RECORD-SETTING ATTENDANCE NUMBERS

Oklahoma has drawn 4,159,261 for Bob Stoops' 52 home games (started in 1999) ...

- All 52 have been sold out and the Sooners prevailed 50 times. The current string of sellouts is second-longest in school history trailing a string of 69 straight from 1971 to 1984.
- Last year's average home attendance of 84,561 was the largest in school history. The top seven seasons for OU home attendance have come on Stoops' watch.
- The crowd of 85,357 for this year's Miami game is the largest in school history. The 84,472 for this year's North Texas game was the largest ever for an OU opener
- OU has exceeded its listed capacity of 82,112 in 26 consecutive games.
- When the game against Texas sold out, it marked the 93rd to do so in Bob Stoops' 111 games as the OU head coach ...
- During those nine years, 8,021,559 fans have been in attendance for Sooner games.
- Some 83.7% of Stoops' games sold out as compared with 83.7 (136-of-190) for Barry Switzer and 37.1% (66-of-178) for Bud Wilkinson.

#### **ABOUT THE OFFENSE**

- Under Stoops, Oklahoma has produced its career leader in passing and receiving, while turning out the No. 3- and No. 4-ranked rusher in school history and the school record holder for single-season rushing, passing and receiving yards.
- OU has scored at least one touchdown in every game dating back to Nov. 7, 1998.
- Under Stoops, OU has rushed for 200 yards 35 times, including 29 over the last five seasons.
- In the Stoops era, OU has 118 TD of 25+ yards and 239 scoring drives of less than 2:00.
- OU's 2006 team missed perfect offensive balance by just 202 yards (2,682 passing, 2,480 rushing). The 2005 team missed it by just one yard and the 2003 squad was off by only 160.

#### BRADFORD HAS SPECIAL TIES TO OU AND THE STATE

Sam Bradford earned the starting quarterback job in August ...

- Bradford is a certified Cherokee Indian. His great, great grandmother (father's side) was named Susie Walkingstick.
- Bradford's father, Kent, was an offensive lineman at OU. He lettered in 1977 and 1978.
- Bradford completed his last 18 passes vs. North Texas and his first four vs. Miami. That string of 22 broke Jason White's OU record of 18 and challenged the NCAA mark of 24 set by Tennessee's Tee Martin. Bradford then hit his last 10 vs. Miami and his first 11 vs. Utah State for a string of 21.

#### **NATIONAL NUMBERS**

Oklahoma's top 25 rankings in the NCAA offensive statistics ...

- No. 1 in passing efficiency at 185.7.
- No. 2 in sacks allowed at .67 per game.
- No. 3 in scoring with 49.7 per game.
- No. 11 in total offense with 482.2 yards per game.
- No. 15 in rushing offense with 216.7 yards per game.
- Sam Bradford is No. 1 in passing eff. (187.0), DeMarco Murray is No. 15 in scoring (10.0) and Juaquin Iglesias is No. 20 in receiving yards/game (93.0).

#### **LINE OF DEMARCATION**

Adrian Peterson was a true freshman in 2004 (age 19) and DeMarco Murray is a redshirt freshman in 2007 (age 19) ...

- Peterson rushed for 15 touchdowns in 2004, one every 22.6 attempts. Murray has nine, one every 7.4 attempts. All of Peterson's TDs came via the rush. Murray has a 10th on a KO return.
- Peterson's long frosh rush was 80 yards vs. Oklahoma St. Murray went 92 yards vs Utah St.
- Peterson had five receptions as a freshman; Murray has eight.

#### **JUA-KEEN IGLESIAS**

- The junior entered the season with 60 career receptions for 804 yards and four touchdowns. In 2007, he has 35 grabs for 558 yards and three scores. His longest reception coming into this season was 37 yards. He already has five for longer distances in '07.
- Career bests in catches (8 vs. Tulsa, Utah St.), yards (142 vs. Tulsa) and TD (2 vs. Tulsa).
- He's averaging 27.3 yards per kickoff return with a long of 44.
- Iglesias' 942 all-purpose yards are 303 more than the next highest figure on the team.

#### **TIGHT END TANDEM**

Last season, tight ends Joe Jon Finley (6-6, 261) and Jermaine Gresham (6-5, 263) combined to average 1.9 receptions/game. Thus far in '07, they're averaging 4.0. In 2006, the tight ends had four touchdown grabs. In 2007 they have six.

#### O-LINE OF HISTORICAL PROPORTIONS

With an average height of nearly 6-5 (76.6 inches) and 322.4 pounds this is one of the biggest offensive lines in OU history. During the Stoops era (since 1999) this is the heaviest line. By height, it is the third-tallest line under Stoops. The 2002 and 2003 lines both measured 77.2 inches. By weight it is the second-heaviest in the country to Texas Tech.

■ At 6-8, Phil Loadholt is tied as the tallest football player ever at OU, and the tallest starter.

#### **ABOUT THE SOONER DEFENSE**

- OU has forced at least one turnover in 100 of Bob Stoops' 111 games and has at least one interception in 74 of the last 97. There have multiple picks in 29 of their last 67 outings.
- Opponents completed 50% or more of their passes in less than half of their games (55-of-111) against Stoops' teams.
- Oklahoma has nine shutouts under its current head coach. Opponents failed to score more than seven points 28 times and scored less than 14 in 54 games.
- Last season, only two of the 14 opponents reached their scoring average in games against Oklahoma and just two were able to exceed their average total yardage figure.

#### **DEFENSE SURGING IN NCAA RANKINGS**

- No. 5 in tackles for loss at 9.5 per game.

- Curtis Lofton ranks No. 17 in tackles (10.7) and Auston English No. 11 in sacks (1.0) and No. 17 in TFL (1.5).

#### **ENGLISH LESSON**

Sophomore defensive end Auston English redshirted after his true freshman season, but is back from that year away from competition in a big way. He leads the Sooners in sacks with six and in tackles for loss with nine. He had two sacks each against Tulsa and Texas.



#### LOFTY ACHIEVEMENT

LB Curtis Lofton registered double-digit tackles in three straight games with 12 vs. Utah State, 14 at Tulsa and a career-high 16 at Colorado. It marked the first time any Sooner had 10 or more stops in three straight games since Lance Mitchell did it in 2002 against South Florida (11), Missouri (15) and Texas (16). Lofton had six against Texas last weekend and came up one shy of tying the school record fo consecutive games with 10+ tackles.

### PAPER OR PLASTIC?

Oklahoma is averaging 3.7 sacks per game. That average over a 12-game schedule would amount to 44 sacks. The school record of 48 was set in 1986. The sack high for this season is six, which OU accomplished against North Texas and Tulsa.

#### **TOUCHY, FEELY DEFENSE**

OU defenders have touched the ball 34 times (5.6 times per game) with 18 PBUs, 10 interceptions and four fumble recoveries. OU is averaging 19.3 yards on INT/fumble returns with three touchdowns.

#### STOOPS ERA STAPLE: RUN DEFENSE

This season, five opponents rushed for 66 or fewer yards. Eighteen times, Bob Stoops-coached Oklahoma teams have held opponents under 40 rushing yards in a game. Four times the total has resulted in negative yards.

- Last season, thanks in part to five sacks, the Sooners limited Baylor to -48 yards on the ground. That was the best single-game rushing defense performance by any team in the nation during the 2006 season and the best by an Oklahoma team during the Stoops Era.
- OU has ranked no worse than 23rd in national rushing defense over the last seven seasons. Three times in that span it ranked among the top 10 and six times it was among the top 20.

#### **TWO-HEADED PUNTER**

Oklahoma used two punters last season and both return ...

- Michael Cohen handles the long punts and is averaging 44.3 yards per boot and ranks No. 19 nationally. Four of his boots covered 50 or more yards with a long of 59 yards at Colorado. He had three 50-yard punts against Texas.
- Mike Knall kicks when it is a short field. He's averaging 36.2 yards with two of four downed inside the 20 yardline.

#### HARTLEY SHOWING OFF BIG LEG

Garrett Hartley, who made a 53-yard field goal vs. Utah State, is averaging 66.9 yards per kickoff (ball lands at the three yard line) with nine touchbacks in 50 attempts. To put that in perspective, opposing kickers average 60.9 yards per kickoff with one touchback.

- Opposing teams are averaging just 21.0 yards per return after Hartley's kickoffs. OU is averaging 28.0 yards per kickoff return.
- Hartley tied a school record when he made 11 point after touchdown kicks in the opener.
- Hit a 28-yard field goal at Colorado had has now made 15 of his last 17.

#### **SOONERS HAVE HART-LEY**

K Garrett Hartley was one of three finalists for the Lou Groza Award and is on the watch list for that award again this year ...

■ Hartley was 19-of-20 on field goals and 49-of-50 on PATs in 2006. His lone field goal miss was a blocked kick at Oregon. He kicked off 78 times with 31 touchbacks.

■ His field goal made percentage of .950 was tops in the nation among kickers with at least 10 makes. He made his last 11 attempts of the season.

■ Hartley ranked No. 20 nationally in field goals made per game with 1.36 and was No. 21 in scoring with 7.57 points per game.

- Hartley made a career-high four field goals at Oregon.
- Hartley has four career makes of 50 yards or longer, including a 53-yarder against Utah State this season. He made a long of 46 yards twice last season.

History is one tough customer at Oklahoma. The tradition, so rich and so long-standing, is as daunting as it is impressive. To be among the best at Oklahoma is to be among the best in college football.

Such dramatics are lost on Bob Stoops. The Sooner head coach befriended the would-be albatross of OU's successful past from his first

day on campus and remains steadfastly focused on tomorrow and the championship it holds.

It falls then to the observers and experts of the game to define Stoops' impact. Rarely have the pundits had it so easy.

Under Stoops,
Oklahoma has won
90 games (91-20),
been ranked for
124 weeks in
the AP Poll (69
consecutive at one
point) and 121 in
the USA Today
Coaches Poll,
played in seven
bowl games, four of
the BCS variety, and

captured three Big 12 crowns. His 2000 team won the national championship. On a playing field leveled by scholarship limits and parity, this era stares down the Oklahoma standard and does not blink.

The achievement dulls the memory of what Stoops inherited. When he arrived in Norman, the proud Sooner program was five years removed from a winning record, four from bowl play. Those atypical days of angst are so forgotten now that they might as well be mentioned with the land rush and dust bowl.

Stoops has been characterized as a grounded family man, brilliant big-game coach, relentless recruiter, disciplined leader and a person with uncommon perspective. His success emanates from a disciplined style true to his roots in the Steel Valley of Ohio, but he is far from inflexible. The principles to which he holds are the tried and true axioms of the sport ... mixed with cutting edge strategy and an appreciation for the calculated risk.

During his time, OU has produced record—setting passers and receivers, three 1,000-yard rushers, suffocating defense and special teams units that rank among the most dynamic in the land. Every facet has been impacted.

His players have snagged 16 national awards, including the 2003 Heisman Trophy won by Jason White. There have been 58 aca-

demic honorees, 53 All-Big 12 players, 22 All-Americans and 32 NFL draft choices.

Stoops has won a total of 10 national coach of the year awards and has been consensus Big 12 Coach of the year in three times.

The son of a coach, Stoops was a four-year starter at lowa. He began his coaching career in 1983 as a volunteer in the Hawkeye program under Hayden Fry. He worked through the ranks until he became co-defenive coordinator at

sive coordinator at Kansas State (1991-95) during Bill Snyders rein.

With the Wildcats, he played a key role in an impressive turnaround. During his final four seasons there, K-State was 35-12 with three bowl appearances. Eventually, he left for Florida and a three-year stint as Steve Spurrier's defensive coordinator. In 1996, he was part of a national championship team. It was with the Gators that the spotlight found Stoops and made him one of the hottest names in the profession.

Stoops, who was born Sept. 9, 1960, in Youngstown, Ohio, graduated from lowa in 1983 with a degree in marketing. He and his wife, Carol, have three children: daughter, Mackenzie, and twin sons, Drake and Isaac.
