# **PLAYER TO WATCH**

Chris Brown became the fourth Oklahoma running back this season to log a multiple touchdown game when he got three against Missouri last Saturday. The sophomore from Alexandria, La., entered the game with no touchdowns in 2007, but crossed the goal line from 1, 4 and 17 yards. A physical back with exceptional vision, Brown has a team-high 19 rushing first downs this season. Against Missouri he was one of five Sooners to carry the ball. he finished with 13 rushes for a game-high 67 yards, an average of 5.2 yards per carry.

# THE GAME

After back-to-back wins over ranked foes (No. 19 Texas, No. 11 Missouri), Oklahoma plays at Iowa State. The Cyclones, who own a win over Iowa, are looking to snap a four-game losing streak. OU has played just one game since Sept. 15, but finishes with three of four Big 12 games in Norman.

### THE SERIES

Oklahoma leads it 66-5-2, including a 32-2-1 advantage in Ames. The Sooners have won the last 10 games and are 37-1-1 in the last 39. Iowa State's last win came in 1990, 33-31, at Norman. OU has won 19 straight in Ames dating back to a 10-6 loss in 1960.

## **THE COACHES**

Oklahoma: Bob Stoops (Iowa '83) is 92-20 in his ninth season with the Sooners. He is 4-4 in bowls, 3-3 in January Bowls, 2-3 in BCS games, 58-12 vs. the Big 12, 32-8 vs. the Big 12 South, 26-4 vs. the Big 12 North, 4-1 in the Big 12 title game, 33-8 vs. non-conference opponents, 51-2 at home, 26-10 on the road, 14-8 on neutral fields and 27-10 vs. ranked foes. He is 4-0 vs. Missouri Iowa State: Gene Chizik (Florida '85) is 1-6 in his first season with the Cyclones and overall.

### **THE PROGRAM**

■ Oklahoma's all-time record stands at 774-293-53. ■ The Sooners own seven national championships (1950, 1955, 1956, 1974, 1975, 1985, 2000). ■ OU has 40 bowl appearances (No. 7 nationally) with 24 victories (No. 3 nationally). Oklahoma has won 40 conference titles. WWII, Oklahoma is the most successful college football program with 530 victories. All-Americans and four Heisman Trophy winners have come from the Oklahoma program.

The luncheon begins at 11:15 a.m., with comments from the head coach of OU's opponent that week (by speaker phone if the coach is available). Lunch is served at 11:30 a.m., and OU head coach Bob Stoops steps to the podium at 12:05 p.m. A limited number of Sooner players are on hand for interviews.

### CREDENTIALS

Requests for credentials are accepted online. To receive the link to the web site, e-mail Kenny Mossman at kmossman@ou.edu. Requests must be submitted by a sports director/editor at least eight days prior to the contest. Media attending games will have passes scanned and must show government issued photo identification upon entering the stadium. If the name on the credential and the photo ID do not match, the credential will be voided.

The University of Oklahoma Athletics Media Relations office has opened a media-only website to assist in covering Sooner sports. The site is valuable for reporters, but also to desk personnel needing stock photographs or similar support. For information on accessing the site, contact Kenny Mossman.

### PRACTICE

All practice sessions are closed to media and public unless otherwise posted. On days when post-practice interviews are conducted, media should gather outside the practice site 10-15 minutes before the workout is complete. Requests for interviews will be recorded at that time and members of the athletics media relations staff will escort media into the practice facility at the appropriate time.

### **INTERVIEWS**

All interview requests should be submitted to the OU Athletic Media Relations Office ... ■ Head Coach Bob Stoops will do general interviews following practice on Monday. All other requests must be submitted to Kenny Mossman.

■ Assistant Coaches: The coaches are available after the Monday-Wednesday practices (coordinators who appear at the Tuesday luncheon are not available that day).

■ Players: All interviews with players will take place at the media luncheon or after practice on Monday and Tuesday. Media should request players at least 24 hours in advance. Those who attend the media luncheon are not available after Tuesday's practice.

■ Post-Game: The OU locker room is closed at all times. Head coach Bob Stoops and several Sooner players will be brought to designated areas. After home games, the interview area is the Switzer Center's Red Room, located under the south end zone grandstand.

### LAST YEAR'S GAME

It was a bittersweet victory when Oklahoma defeated Iowa State, 34-9, last season ...

■ It was the sixth game of the season but the final regular season contest for Adrian Peterson, who broke his collarbone on his final rush of the game. He finished the contest with 183 yards, including 53 that came on that last attempt, which also went for a touchdown. That was one of two touchdowns in the game for Peterson. Malcolm Kelly also had two with from 9 and 15 yards.

■ Oklahoma quarterback Paul Thompson hit 16-of-27 passes for 195 yards and two touchdowns with no interceptions.

■ The Cyclones had 238 total yards, including 149 through the air. The lone ISU touchdown came on a 31-yard pass from Bret Meyer to Todd Blythe.

## **OKLAHOMA'S MOST RECENT GAME**

No. 5 Oklahoma turned five Missouri turnovers into 24 points and downed the No. 11 Tigers at Norman, 41-31  $\ldots$ 

■ Oklahoma trailed twice in the game, 7-0 and 24-23. The Soon-

ers reeled off three straight touchdowns in the fourth quarter to turn that last deficit into a 41-24 lead.

■ Sam Bradford was brilliant again completing 24-of-34 for 266 yards with two touchdowns and no interceptions.

Chris Brown rushed for a career-high three touchdowns from 1, 4 and 17 yards.

Curtis Lofton, who registered a career-high 18 tackles, scored his second touchdown of the season when he returned a fumble 12 yards for a score.

■ Oklahoma picked off three passes, including two thrown by Chase Daniel. OU now has five interceptions against the Tiger quarterback in two games. Daniel has thrown just 18 picks in his three-year career.

## SOONERS DIGGING THE LONG BALL

OU has 70 plays, offense and defense, of 20 yards or longer (not including special teams) ...

- Plays of 20-29 Yards -- 31 plays (three rushes, 13 passes) and seven touchdowns.
- Plays of 30-39 Yards -- 18 plays (three rushes, five passes) and five touchdowns
- Plays of 40+ Yards -- 21 plays (six rushes, nine passes) and 11 touchdowns.

**Notes:** Four Sooners have a rush of 41 yards or longer ... OU has a 53-yard FG from Garrett Hartley ... OU's opponents have 16 plays (14 passes) of 20+ yards ... OU's longest play was a 92-yard touchdown run by DeMarco Murray vs. Utah State ... he also had an 81-yard kickoff return at Tulsa.

## MISCELLANY

■ Oklahoma has scored in 26 of 28 quarters this season. The exceptions were the fourth quarters against Utah State and Colorado.

- Oklahoma opponents are 2-of-21 on third down in the fourth quarter.
- Oklahoma has had a 100-yard receiver in five of seven games this season.

■ DeMarco Murray and Allen Patrick both have 100-yard rushing games this season. It marks the fifth consecutive season that more than one tailback achieved the feat in the same year. Those two average 6.3 and 6.1 yards per carry, respectively.

- OU has four, one-play scoring drives. Three of those plays were rushes and the shortest, a rush, was 17 yards.
- OU has two, 90-yard scoring drives: 96 against Utah State and 94 against Texas.
- OU opponents are 33-of-110 on third down for 30.0%. OU is 45-of-89 for 50.6%.
- OU ran between 67 and 73 (73 three times) plays in its six wins, 46 in its loss.
- Rushing -- OU 276 attempts for 1,415 yards (5.1/carry); opponents 241 for 456 (1.9/carry).
- Oklahoma has 12 turnovers as opposed to 18 by the opponents. OU scored 83 points (8 TD,
- 1 FG) off the turnovers, the opponents have 44 (5 TD, 3 FG).

### THE SOONERS BRIEFLY

■ Oklahoma was tabbed for a second-place finish in the Big 12's South Division in a preseason polling of league media. Defensive back Reggie Smith was named the league's preseason defensive player of the year.

■ There are 34 players on this team with previous experience as a starter for OU. That's up from 10 over the number that returned last season.

### HOME FIELD HONCHOS

■ Oklahoma is 51-2 at Gaylord Family - Oklahoma Memorial Stadium under Bob Stoops and has won its last 15 in a row there and 35 of its last 36. During Stoops's tenure, which included home winning streaks of 19 and 17 games, OU has registered six shutouts on Owen Field.

■ The Sooners are 27-1 against the Big 12 at home under their current head coach and have won their last 18 conference games on Owen Field.

## **GREAT SLATE**

■ Oklahoma has played exclusive Football Bowl Subdivision (formerly I-A) opposition since Bob Stoops' opener in 1999 (a 49-0 win over I-AA Indiana State) or for 110 consecutive games. The entire 2007 schedule is comprised of FBS competition.

■ Under Stoops, Oklahoma has played regular season games against Notre Dame, UCLA (twice), Alabama (twice), Oregon (twice), Miami, Louisville, North Carolina, Air Force and Washington. Future slates feature Miami, Washington, Tennessee, Notre Dame, LSU and Florida State.

### **CLOSE SHAVES**

Oklahoma's loss at Colorado marked the fourth time in the last five Sooner setbacks that the game was decided on the game's final play: 2007 Colorado (CU field goal), 2007 Fiesta Bowl (Boise State TD), 2006 Oregon (blocked Oklahoma field goal attempt) and 2005 Texas Tech (TTU touchdown). Those four losses were by a total of seven points (27-24 at Colorado, 43-42 to Boise State, 34-33 at Oregon and 23-21 at Texas Tech), and all were away from Norman.

## STOOPS ERA YIELDING RECORD-SETTING ATTENDANCE NUMBERS

Oklahoma has drawn 4,244,302 for Bob Stoops' 53 home games (started in 1999) ...

■ All 53 have been sold out and the Sooners prevailed 52 times. The current string of sellouts is second-longest in school history trailing a string of 69 straight from 1971 to 1984.

- Last year's average home attendance of 84,561 was the largest in school history. The top seven seasons for OU home attendance have come on Stoops' watch.
- The crowd of 85,357 for this year's Miami game is the largest in school history. The 84,472 for this year's North Texas game was the largest ever for an OU opener
- OU has exceeded its listed capacity of 82,112 in 27 consecutive games.

■ When the game against Missouri sold out, it marked the 94th (home, away and neutral) to do so in Bob Stoops' 112 games as the OU head coach.

During those nine years, 8,106,960 fans have been in attendance for Sooner games.

Some 83.9% of Stoops' games sold out as compared with 83.7 (136-of-190) for Barry

Switzer and 37.1% (66-of-178) for Bud Wilkinson.

### **ABOUT THE OFFENSE**

■ Under Stoops, Oklahoma has produced its career leader in passing and receiving, while turning out the No. 3- and No. 4-ranked rusher in school history and the school record holder for single-season rushing, passing and receiving yards.

- OU has scored at least one touchdown in every game dating back to Nov. 7, 1998.
- Under Stoops, OU has rushed for 200 yards 35 times, including 29 over the last five seasons.
- In the Stoops era, OU has 119 TD of 25+ yards and 242 scoring drives of less than 2:00.
- OU's 2006 team missed perfect offensive balance by just 202 yards (2,682 passing, 2,480

rushing). The 2005 team missed it by just one yard and the 2003 squad was off by only 160.

### **BRADFORD HAS SPECIAL TIES TO OU AND THE STATE**

Sam Bradford earned the starting quarterback job in August ...

■ Bradford is a certified Cherokee Indian. His great, great grandmother (father's side) was named Susie Walkingstick.

Bradford's father, Kent, was an offensive lineman at OU. He lettered in 1977 and 1978.
 He completed his last 18 passes vs. North Texas and his first four vs. Miami. That string of 22 broke Jason White's OU record of 18 and challenged the NCAA mark of 24 set by Tennessee's Tee Martin. Bradford then hit his last 10 vs. Miami and first 11 vs. Utah State for a string of 21.
 Multiple TD passes in six games, school record (tied) five TD passes vs. North Texas, hit at least 65% in six games, no INT in four games, at least one 30-yard pass in every game.

### NATIONAL NUMBERS

Oklahoma's top 25 rankings in the NCAA offensive statistics ...

■ No. 1 in passing efficiency at 180.6. ■ No. 4 in scoring with 48.4 per game. ■ No. 6 in sacks allowed at .71 per game. ■ No. 14 in total offense with 468.1 yards per game. ■ No. 21 in rushing offense with 202.1 yards per game. ■ Sam Bradford is No. 1 in passing eff. (187.0), Juaquin Iglesias is No. 25 in receiving yards/game (90.7).

### LINE OF DEMARCATION

Adrian Peterson was a true frosh in '04 (age 19; DeMarco Murray a redshirt in '07 (age 19) ...
Peterson rushed for 15 touchdowns in 2004, one every 22.6 attempts. Murray has nine, one every 7.9 attempts. All of Peterson's TDs came via the rush. Murray has a 10th on a KO return.
Peterson's long frosh rush was 80 yards vs. Oklahoma St. Murray went 92 yards vs Utah St.
Peterson had five receptions as a freshman; Murray has 10.

### JUA-KEEN IGLESIAS

■ The junior entered the season with 60 career receptions for 804 yards and four touchdowns. In 2007, he has 42 grabs for 635 yards and four scores. His longest reception coming into this season was 37 yards. He already has five for longer distances in '07.

- Career bests in catches (8 vs. Tulsa, Utah St.), yards (142 vs. Tulsa) and TD (2 vs. Tulsa).
- He's averaging 28.7 yards per kickoff return (No. 19 nationally) with a long of 44.
- Iglesias' 1,069 all-purpose yards are 346 more than the next highest figure on the team.

### TIGHT END TANDEM

Last season, Joe Jon Finley and Jermaine Gresham combined to average 1.9 receptions/game and scored four TD. In '07, they're averaging 4.3 receptions and have seven TD.

### **O-LINE OF HISTORICAL PROPORTIONS**

With an average height of 6-5 (76.6 inches) and 322.4 pounds this is one of the biggest offensive lines in OU history. In the Stoops era this is the heaviest line and the third-tallest. The 2002 and 2003 lines measured 77.2 inches.

At 6-8, Phil Loadholt is tied as the tallest football player ever at OU, and the tallest starter.

### **KEEPING THE QB CLEAN**

OU allows 0.7 sacks per game. The school record for fewest sacks allowed in a season was set last season at 1.1 (sacks record tracked only on teams with at least 100 passing attempts).

## **ABOUT THE SOONER DEFENSE**

OU has forced at least one turnover in 101 of Bob Stoops' 112 games and has at least one interception in 75 of the last 98. There have multiple picks in 30 of their last 68 outings.

Oklahoma has nine shutouts under its current head coach. Opponents failed to score more than seven points 28 times and scored less than 14 in 54 games.

Last season, only two of the 14 opponents reached their scoring average in games against Oklahoma and just two were able to exceed their average total yardage figure.

### **ENGLISH LESSON**

Sophomore DE Auston English redshirted after his true freshman season, but is back from that year away from competition in a big way. He leads the Sooners in sacks with 7.5 and in tackles for loss with 11.

Over the last two games, both against ranked opponents, English has 3.5 sacks with two against Texas and 1.5 against

Missouri. Also in that span, he logged 14 of his 28 tackles, including a career-high nine against the Tigers.

## PAPER OR PLASTIC?

Oklahoma is averaging 3.7 sacks per game. That average over a 12-game schedule would amount to 44 sacks. The school record of 48 was set in 1986. The sack high for this season is six, which OU accomplished against North Texas and Tulsa.

### WHAT HAVE YOU DONE FOR ME LATELY?

- With 239 INT return yards, OU has exceeded its total for each of the last three years.
- With 25 sacks through seven games, OU is just one shy of its 14

### **TOUCHY, FEELY DEFENSE**

OU defenders have touched the ball 40 times (5.7 times per game) with 22 PBUs, 13 interceptions and five fumble recoveries. To put that in perspective, opposing teams have just 24 touches in 12 break-ups, eight fumble recoveries and five interceptions. OU is averaging 17.3 yards on INT/fumble returns with four touchdowns, which is one shy of the school record set in 1956 and 2001.

### **STOOPS ERA STAPLE: RUN DEFENSE**

This season, six opponents rushed for 66 or fewer yards. Eighteen times, Bob Stoops-coached Oklahoma teams have held opponents under 40 rushing yards in a game. Four times the total has resulted in negative yards.

# ABOUT THE SOONER SPECIAL TEAMS

Oklahoma's special teams under Bob Stoops ...

There have been 25 special teams touchdowns, including 18 in the last 61 regular season games. Those 18 came via five different kinds of plays -- 10 punt returns, two faked field goals, two blocked punts, three kickoff returns and a faked punt. Special teams also own one safety in that span.

- In total, OU has returned six kickoffs and 14 punts for TDs on Stoops' watch (since 1999).
- The Sooners have blocked 20 kicks.

# **TWO-HEADED PUNTER**

Oklahoma used two punters last season and both return ...

Michael Cohen handles the long punts and is averaging 44.9 yards per boot and ranks No. 13 nationally. Five of his boots covered 50 or more yards with a long of 59 yards at Colorado. He had three 50-vard punts against Texas and now has a 50-varder in three straight games.

Mike Knall kicks when it is a short field. He's averaging 36.2 yards with two of four downed inside the 20 yardline.

# HARTLEY SHOWING OFF BIG LEG

Garrett Hartley, who made a 53-yard field goal vs. Utah State, is averaging 67.2 yards per kickoff (ball lands at the three yard line) with 14 touchbacks in 50 attempts. To put that in perspective, opposing kickers average 61.6 yards per kickoff with two touchbacks.

Opposing teams are averaging just 21.9 yards per return after Hartley's kickoffs. OU is averaging 28.7 yards per kickoff return.

- Hartley tied a school record when he made 11 point after touchdown kicks in the opener.
- Hit a 28-yard field goal at Colorado had has now made 16 of his last 18.

# **SOONERS HAVE HART-LEY**

K Garrett Hartley was one of three finalists for the Lou Groza Award and is on the watch list for that award again this year ...

■ Hartley was 19-of-20 on field goals and 49-of-50 on PATs in 2006. His lone field goal miss was a blocked kick at Oregon. He kicked off 78 times with 31 touchbacks.

His field goal made percentage of .950 was tops in the nation among kickers with at least 10 makes. He made his last 11 attempts of the season.

- Hartley ranked No. 20 nationally in field goals made per game with 1.36 and was No. 21 in scoring with 7.57 points per game.

The tradition, so rich and so long-standing, is as daunting as it is impressive. To be among the best at Oklahoma is to be among the best in college football.

Such dramatics are lost on Bob Stoops. The Sooner head coach befriended the would-be albatross of OU's successful past from his first

day on campus and remains steadfastly focused on tomorrow and the championship it holds.

It falls then to the observers and experts of the game to define Stoops' impact. Rarely have the pundits had it so easy. Under Stoops, Oklahoma has won 92 games (92-20), been ranked for 125 weeks in the AP Poll (69 consecutive at one point) and 122 in the USA Today Coaches Poll, played in seven bowl games, four of the BCS variety, and

captured three Big 12 crowns. His 2000 team won the national championship. On a playing field leveled by scholarship limits and parity, this era stares down the Oklahoma standard and does not blink.

The achievement dulls the memory of what Stoops inherited. When he arrived in Norman, the proud Sooner program was five years removed from a winning record, four from bowl play. Those atypical days of angst are so forgotten now that they might as well be mentioned with the land rush and dust bowl.

Stoops has been characterized as a grounded family man, brilliant big-game coach, relentless recruiter, disciplined leader and a person with uncommon perspective. His success emanates from a disciplined style true to his roots in the Steel Valley of Ohio, but he is far from inflexible. The principles to which he holds are the tried and true axioms of the sport ... mixed with cutting edge strategy and an appreciation for the calculated risk. During his time, OU has produced record– setting passers and receivers, three 1,000-yard rushers, suffocating defense and special teams units that rank among the most dynamic in the land. Every facet has been impacted.

His players have snagged 16 national awards, including the 2003 Heisman Trophy won by Jason White. There have been 58 aca-

> demic honorees, 53 All-Big 12 players, 22 All-Americans and 32 NFL draft choices.

Stoops has won a total of 10 national coach of the year awards and has been consensus Big 12 Coach of the year in three times.

The son of a coach, Stoops was a four-year starter at lowa. He began his coaching career in 1983 as a volunteer in the Hawkeye program under Hayden Fry. He worked through the ranks until he became co-defensive coordinator at

Kansas State (1991-95) during Bill Snyders rein.

With the Wildcats, he played a key role in an impressive turnaround. During his final four seasons there, K-State was 35-12 with three bowl appearances. Eventually, he left for Florida and a three-year stint as Steve Spurrier's defensive coordinator. In 1996, he was part of a national championship team. It was with the Gators that the spotlight found Stoops and made him one of the hottest names in the profession.

Stoops, who was born Sept. 9, 1960, in Youngstown, Ohio, graduated from Iowa in 1983 with a degree in marketing. He and his wife, Carol, have three children: daughter, Mackenzie, and twin sons, Drake and Isaac.
