SENIOR SALUTE

This is the final home game for 19 seniors: LB Lewis Baker (pictured), WR Garrett Bothun, P Michael Cohen, DT Steven Coleman, DE Alonzo Dotson, WR Russell English, TE Joe Jon Finley, RB Jacob Gutierrez, K Garrett Hartley, QB Hays McEachern, OG Sherrone Moore, RB Allen Patrick, LB Demarrio Pleasant, FB Ian Pleasant, CB Marcus Walker, WR Chase Wasson, DB Darien Williams, SS D.J. Wolfe and FB Dane Zaslaw. Over the last four years, OU is 40-11 with two Big 12 Championships and appearances in the Orange, Holiday and Fiesta Bowls.

THE GAME

Oklahoma closes the regular season portion of the schedule when it hosts Oklahoma State. A win by the Sooners would clinch the Big 12 South Division and a trip to the Dr Pepper Big 12 Championship in San Antonio.

THE SERIES

Oklahoma leads it by 78-16-7, the widest margin nationally between instrastate rivals. OU holds a 37-8-2 advantage in Norman. The Sooners have won their last four meetings with the Cowboys.

THE COACHES

Oklahoma: Bob Stoops (Iowa '83) is 95-21 in his ninth season with the Sooners. He is 4-4 in bowls, 3-3 in January Bowls, 2-3 in BCS games, 61-13 vs. the Big 12, 34-9 vs. the Big 12 South, 27-4 vs. the Big 12 North, 4-1 in the Big 12 title game, 33-8 vs. non-conference opponents, 53-2 at home, 27-11 on the road, 14-8 on neutral fields and 27-10 vs. ranked foes. He is 6-2 vs. OSU. Oklahoma State: Mike Gundy (Oklahoma State '90) is 17-18 in his third year at OSU. He is 0-2 vs. Oklahoma.

THE PROGRAM

■ Oklahoma's all-time record stands at 777-294-53. ■ The Sooners own seven national championships (1950, 1955, 1956, 1974, 1975, 1985, 2000). ■ OU has 40 bowl appearances (No. 7 nationally) with 24 victories (No. 3 nationally). ■ Oklahoma has won 40 conference titles. ■ Since WWII, Oklahoma is the most successful college football program with 533 victories. ■ Some 142 All-Americans and four Heisman Trophy winners have come from the Oklahoma program.

WEEKLY MEDIA LUNCHEON

Each Tuesday during the season OU hosts a media luncheon inside the Kerr McGee Stadium Club (east side) at Gaylord Family - Oklahoma Memorial Stadium. The luncheon begins at 11:15 a.m., with comments from the head coach of OU's opponent that week (by speaker phone if the coach is available). Lunch is served at 11:30 a.m., and OU head coach Bob Stoops steps to the podium at 12:05 p.m. A limited number of Sooner players are on hand for interviews.

CREDENTIALS

Requests for credentials are accepted online. To receive the link to the web site, e-mail Kenny Mossman at kmossman@ou.edu. Requests must be submitted by a sports director/editor at least eight days prior to the contest. Media attending games will have passes scanned and must show government issued photo identification upon entering the stadium. If the name on the credential and the photo ID do not match, the credential will be voided.

The University of Oklahoma Athletics Media Relations office has a media-only website to assist in covering Sooner sports. The site is valuable for reporters, but also to desk personnel needing stock photographs or similar support. To access the site, contact Kenny Mossman.

PRACTICE

All practice sessions are closed to media and public unless otherwise posted. On days when post-practice interviews are conducted, media should gather outside the practice site 10-15 minutes before the workout is complete. Requests for interviews will be recorded and members of the athletics media relations staff will escort media into the facility at the appropriate time.

INTERVIEWS

All interview requests should be submitted to the OU Athletic Media Relations Office ...

- Head Coach Bob Stoops will do general interviews following practice on Monday. All other requests must be submitted to Kenny Mossman.
- Assistant Coaches: The coaches are available after the Monday-Wednesday practices (coordinators who appear at the Tuesday luncheon are not available that day).
- Players: All interviews with players will take place at the media luncheon or after practice on Monday and Tuesday. Media should request players at least 24 hours in advance. Those who attend the media luncheon are not available after Tuesday's practice.
- Post-Game: The OU locker room is closed at all times. Head coach Bob Stoops and several Sooner players will be brought to designated areas. After home games, the interview area is the Switzer Center's Red Room, located under the south end zone grandstand.

LAST YEAR'S GAME

Oklahoma won at Stillwater, 27-21, to clinch the Big 12 South title ...

- Coupled with Texas' loss to Texas A&M the day before, the outcome sent Oklahoma to the Big 12 title game at Kansas City where it vanguished Nebraska, 21-7.
- Allen Patrick, who had missed the previous two games due to injury, carried 23 times for 163 yards and one touchdown, a 65-yarder on his first attempt of the second half. The Sooners rushed 47 times for 238 yards while attempting just 11 passes (7-of-11 for 77 yards).
- Other OU touchdowns came from Chris Brown, who scored from three yards and one yard out, and Juaquin Iglesias, who hauled in a 13-yard pass from Paul Thompson.
- The Sooners trailed 7-0, but took a 13-7 lead by halftime and were never headed again.
- A crowd of 42,819 witnessed the game.

OKLAHOMA'S MOST RECENT GAME

Oklahoma dropped a 34-27 decision at Texas Tech last Saturday ...

- Quarterback Sam Bradford was injured on the first play of the game and missed nearly all of the contest. He was 2-of-3 for 11 yards. His back-up, Joey Halzle, completed 21-of-41 passes for 291 yards with two touchdowns and one interception.
- DeMarco Murray, who also was injured late in the game, was OU's top rusher with 19 attempts for 94 yards.
- Texas Tech's Graham Harrell hit on 47-of-72 passes for 420 yards and two touchdowns. He was intercepted twice. One of the picks was returned 63 yards for a TD by Lendy Holmes.
- Garrett Hartley made both of his field goal attempts for Oklahoma from 20 and 33 yards.
- Curtis Lofton topped Oklahoma's defense with 12 tackles and one interception.
- DE Auston English missed the game due to injury.
- Tech finished with 473 total yards, Oklahoma with 408.

SOONERS DIGGING THE LONG BALL

OU has 52 plays, offense and defense, of 20 yards or longer (not including special teams) ...

- Plays of 20-29 Yards -- 40 plays and nine touchdowns.
- Plays of 30-39 Yards -- 22 plays and six touchdowns
- Plays of 40+ Yards -- 28 plays and 14 touchdowns.
- OU's Big-Play (20+ yards) Breakdown -- 42 passing (16 TD), 14 rushing (9 TD), seven interceptions (three TD), one fumble return (one TD).

Notes: Four Sooners have a rush of 41 yards or longer ... OU's opponents have 25 plays (19 passes) of 20+ yards ... OU's longest play was a 92-yard touchdown run by DeMarco Murray vs. Utah State ... he also had a 91-uard kickoff return against Baylor and an 81-yard kickoff return at Tulsa ... Juaquin Iglesias has the most plays of 20 or more yards with 23 with 13 of those on kickoff returns ... from scrimmage, Malcolm Kelly leads with 13, eight of which were TD ... Oklahoma leads the nation with 25 offensive scoring plays of 20+ yards.

MISCELLANY

- When Sam Bradford was knocked out of the Texas Tech game it marked the first time that a starting OU quarterback missed more than one quarter of play due to injury since Jason White suffered a torn ACL against Alabama in the second game of the 2002 season.
- Oklahoma has scored in 34 of 35 quarters this season.
- Oklahoma has had a 100-yard receiver in six games, a 100-yard rusher in four.
- DeMarco Murray and Allen Patrick both have 100-yard rushing games this season. It marks the fifth consecutive season that more than one tailback achieved the feat in the same year. Those two average 6.0 and 5.4 yards per carry, respectively.
- OU has five, one-play scoring drives. Three of those plays were rushes and the shortest, a rush, was 17 yards.
- OU has three, 90-yard scoring drives: 96 vs. Utah State, 94 vs. Texas, 91 vs. Texas Tech.
- OU opponents are 52-of-168 on third down for 31.0%. OU is 71-of-147 for 48.3%.
- Oklahoma opponents are 6-of-36 (16.7%)on third down in the fourth quarter.
- The Sooners ran 73 plays in five games this season, 72 in another.
- Rushing -- OU: 435 attempts for 2,020 yards (4.6/carry); opponents: 352 for 902 (2.6/carry).
- OU has forced multiple turnovers in nine game.

THE SOONERS BRIEFLY

- Oklahoma was tabbed for a second-place finish in the Big 12's South Division in a preseason polling of league media. Defensive back Reggie Smith was named the league's preseason defensive player of the year.
- There are 34 players on this team with previous experience as a starter for OU. That's up from 10 over the number that returned last season.

HOME FIELD HONCHOS

- Oklahoma is 53-2 at home under Bob Stoops and has won its last 17 in a row there and 37 of its last 38. During Stoops's tenure, which included two home winning streaks of 19, OU has registered six shutouts on Owen Field.
- The Sooners are 29-1 against the Big 12 at home under Stoops and have won their last 20 conference games on Owen Field.

GREAT SLATE

- Oklahoma has played exclusive Football Bowl Subdivision (formerly I-A) opposition since Bob Stoops' opener in 1999 (a 49-0 win over I-AA Indiana State) or for 113 consecutive games.
- Under Stoops, Oklahoma has played regular season games against Notre Dame, UCLA (twice), Alabama (twice), Oregon (twice), Miami, Louisville, North Carolina, Air Force and Washington. Future slates feature Miami, Washington, Tennessee, Notre Dame, LSU and Florida State.

CLOSE SHAVES

Oklahoma's loss at Colorado marked the fourth time in the last six Sooner setbacks that the game was decided on the game's final play: 2007 Colorado (CU field goal), 2007 Fiesta Bowl (Boise State TD), 2006 Oregon (blocked Oklahoma field goal attempt) and 2005 Texas Tech (TTU touchdown). Those four losses were by a total of seven points (27-24 at Colorado, 43-42 to Boise State, 34-33 at Oregon and 23-21 at Texas Tech), and all were away from Norman.

STOOPS ERA YIELDING RECORD-SETTING ATTENDANCE NUMBERS

Oklahoma has drawn 4,413,796 for Bob Stoops' 55 home games (started in 1999) ...

- All 55 have been sold out and the Sooners prevailed 53 times. The current string of sellouts is second-longest in school history trailing a string of 69 straight from 1971 to 1984.
- Last year's average home attendance of 84,561 was the largest in school history. The top seven seasons for OU home attendance have come on Stoops' watch.
- The crowd of 85,357 for this year's Miami game is the largest in school history. The 84,472 for this year's North Texas game was the largest ever for an OU opener
- OU has exceeded its listed capacity of 82,112 in 29 consecutive games.
- When the game at Texas Tech sold out, it marked the 97th (home, away and neutral) to do so in Bob Stoops' 116 games as the OU head coach.
- During those nine years, 8,381,003 fans have been in attendance for Sooner games.
- Some 83.6% of Stoops' games sold out as compared with 83.7 (136-of-190) for Barry Switzer and 37.1% (66-of-178) for Bud Wilkinson.

ABOUT THE OFFENSE

- Under Stoops, Oklahoma has produced its career leader in passing and receiving, while turning out the No. 3- and No. 4-ranked rusher in school history and the school record holder for single-season rushing, passing and receiving yards.
- OU has scored at least one touchdown in every game dating back to Nov. 7, 1998.
- Under Stoops, OU has rushed for 200 yards 35 times, including 29 over the last five seasons.
- In the Stoops era, OU has 123 TD of 25+ yards and 244 scoring drives of less than 2:00.
- OU's 2006 team missed perfect offensive balance by just 202 yards (2,682 passing, 2,480 rushing). The 2005 team missed it by just one yard and the 2003 squad was off by only 160.

BRADFORD HAS SPECIAL TIES TO OU AND THE STATE

Sam Bradford earned the starting quarterback job in August ...

- Bradford is a certified Cherokee Indian. His great, great grandmother (father's side) was named Susie Walkingstick.
- Bradford's father, Kent, was an offensive lineman at OU. He lettered in 1977 and 1978.
- He completed his last 18 passes vs. North Texas and his first four vs. Miami. That string of 22 broke Jason White's OU record of 18 and challenged the NCAA mark of 24 set by Tennessee's Tee Martin. Bradford then hit his last 10 vs. Miami and first 11 vs. Utah State for a string of 21.
- Multiple TD passes in eight games, school record (tied) five TD passes vs. Miami and Texas A&M, hit at least 65% in nine games, no INT in five games, at least one 30-yard pass in every game.

NATIONAL NUMBERS

Oklahoma's top 25 rankings in the NCAA offensive statistics ...

■ No. 2 in passing efficiency at 171.39. ■ No. 4 in scoring with 43.4 per game. ■ No. 4 in sacks allowed at 0.9 per game. ■ No. 17 in total offense with 454.91 yards per game. ■ Sam Bradford is No. 1 in passing efficiency (175.15).

LINE OF DEMARCATION

Adrian Peterson was a true frosh in '04 (age 19; DeMarco Murray a redshirt in '07 (age 19) ...

- Peterson rushed for 15 touchdowns in 2004, one every 22.6 attempts. Murray has 13, one every 9.8 attempts. All of Peterson's TDs came via the rush. Murray has two more on kick returns
- Peterson's long frosh rush was 80 yards vs. Oklahoma St. Murray went 92 yards vs Utah St.
- Peterson had five receptions as a freshman; Murray has 14.

JUA-KEEN IGLESIAS

- The junior entered the season with 60 career receptions for 804 yards and four touchdowns. In 2007, he has 55 grabs for 778 yards and four scores. His longest reception coming into this season was 37 yards. He already has six for longer distances in '07.
- Career bests in catches (8 vs. Tulsa, Utah St.), yards (142 vs. Tulsa) and TD (2 vs. Tulsa).
- He's averaging 29.0 yards per kickoff return (No. 13 nationally) with a long of 49.
- Iglesias' 1,416 all-purpose yards are 153 more than the next highest figure on the team.

TIGHT END TANDEM

Last season, Joe Jon Finley and Jermaine Gresham combined to average 1.9 receptions/game and scored four touchdowns. In '07, they're averaging 4.1 receptions and have 11 TD.

O-LINE OF HISTORICAL PROPORTIONS

With an average height of 6-5 (76.6 inches) and 322.4 pounds this is one of the biggest offensive lines in OU history. In the Stoops era this is the heaviest line and the third-tallest. The 2002 and 2003 lines measured 77.2 inches.

■ At 6-8, Phil Loadholt is tied as the tallest football player ever at OU, and the tallest starter.

KEEPING THE QB CLEAN

OU allows 0.9 sacks per game. The school record for fewest sacks allowed in a season was set last season at 1.1 (sacks record tracked only on teams with at least 100 passing attempts).



ABOUT THE SOONER DEFENSE

- OU has forced at least one turnover in 105 of Bob Stoops' 116 games and has at least one interception in 78 of the last 102. There have multiple picks in 32 of their last 72 outings.
- Oklahoma has nine shutouts under its current head coach. Opponents failed to score more than seven points 29 times and scored less than 14 in 55 games.

- No. 5 in rushing defense at 82.0 yards per game.

ENGLISH LESSON

Sophomore DE Auston English redshirted after his true freshman season, but is back from that year away from competition in a big way. He leads the Sooners in sacks with 9.5 and in tackles for loss with 13.

■ With 9.5 sacks, English is tied with Torrance Marshall (1999) for the 14th-best single season total in school history. The OU record of 14 is held by Martin Chase (1997) and Cedric Jones (1994). The best total in the Stoops era was 10 by Calvin Thibodeaux (2005) and Dan Cody (2004, 2003).

PAPER OR PLASTIC?

Oklahoma is averaging 2.7 sacks per game. That average over a 13-game schedule would amount to 35 sacks. The school record of 48 was set in 1986. The sack high for this season is six vs. North Texas and Tulsa.

WHAT HAVE YOU DONE FOR ME LATELY?

- With 320 INT return yards, OU has exceeded its total for each of the four three years.
- With 29 sacks, OU is four ahead of its 14-game total in 2006.

TOUCHY, FEELY DEFENSE

OU defenders have touched the ball 64 times (5.8 times per game) with 39 PBUs, 18 interceptions and seven fumble recoveries. To put that in perspective, opposing teams have just 43 touches in 24 break-ups, 11 fumble recoveries and seven interceptions. OU is averaging 15.1 yards on INT/fumble returns with five touchdowns to tie the school record set in 1956, 2000 and 2001.

STOOPS ERA STAPLE: RUN DEFENSE

This season, six opponents rushed for 66 or fewer yards. Eighteen times, Bob Stoops-coached Oklahoma teams have held opponents under 40 rushing yards in a game. Four times the total has resulted in negative yards.

■ Sooner opponents have just 49 rushing first downs.



LB Curtis Lofton ranks No. 7 nationally with 11.2 tackles per game. His 112 stops include seven double-digit games and a career-high 18 vs. Missouri. He also has a pair of TD with a 45-yard interception return (Utah) State and a 12-yard fumble return (Missouri).

- In total, OU has returned eight kickoffs and 14 punts for TDs on Stoops' watch (since 1999).
- The Sooners have blocked 20 kicks.

- DeMarco Murray ran 81 yards for a touchdown against Tulsa on the second kickoff return of his college career. His first came earlier in the same game. He then went for 91 yards and a touchdown against Baylor.

TWO-HEADED PUNTER

Oklahoma used two punters in 2006 and 2007 with Michael Cohen and Mike Knall sharing the duties. Knall, formerly the short-field punter, handled all seven punts at Texas Tech and averaged 47.4 yards with a long of 60 (longest of the season for the team) and one downed inside the 20.

HARTLEY SHOWING OFF BIG LEG

Garrett Hartley, who made a 53-yard field goal vs. Utah State, is averaging 66.8 yards per kick-off (ball lands at the three yard line) with 25 touchbacks in 83 attempts. To put that in perspective, opposing kickers average 61.2 yards per kickoff with two touchbacks in 43 tries.

- Opposing teams are averaging just 21.9 yards per return after Hartley's kickoffs. OU is averaging 28.4 yards per kickoff return.
- Hartley tied a school record when he made 11 point after touchdown kicks in the opener.
- He has made 18 of his last 20 field goal attempts, including a 43-yarder at lowa State, and two at Texas Tech.

SOONERS HAVE HART-LEY

K Garrett Hartley was one of three finalists for the Lou Groza Award and is on the watch list for that award again this year ...

- Hartley ranks No. 5 in career kick scoring at OU (285), No. 4 in career field goals (43) and No. 5 in career PAT (156).
- Hartley made 19-of-20 FG and 49-of-50 on PAT in 2006. His lone field goal miss was a block at Oregon (made a career-high four FG in that game). He kicked off 78 times with 31 touchbacks.
- His FG made percentage of .950 was tops in the nation among kickers with at least 10 makes. He made his last 11 attempts of the season.
- Hartley ranked No. 20 nationally in field goals made per game with 1.36 and was No. 21 in scoring with 7.57 points per game.
- Hartley has four career makes of 50 yards or longer, including a 53-yarder against Utah State this season. He made a long of 46 yards twice last season.

History is one tough customer at Oklahoma. The tradition, so rich and so long-standing, is as daunting as it is impressive. To be among the best at Oklahoma is to be among the best in college football.

Such dramatics are lost on Bob Stoops. The Sooner head coach befriended the would-be albatross of OU's successful past from his first

day on campus and remains steadfastly focused on tomorrow and the championship it holds.

It falls then to the observers and experts of the game to define Stoops' impact. Rarely have the pundits had it so easy.

Under Stoops,
Oklahoma has won

played in seven
bowl games, four of
the BCS variety, and

captured three Big 12 crowns. His 2000 team won the national championship. On a playing field leveled by scholarship limits and parity, this era stares down the Oklahoma standard and does not blink.

The achievement dulls the memory of what Stoops inherited. When he arrived in Norman, the proud Sooner program was five years removed from a winning record, four from bowl play. Those atypical days of angst are so forgotten now that they might as well be mentioned with the land rush and dust bowl.

Stoops has been characterized as a grounded family man, brilliant big-game coach, relentless recruiter, disciplined leader and a person with uncommon perspective. His success emanates from a disciplined style true to his roots in the Steel Valley of Ohio, but he is far from inflexible. The principles to which he holds are the tried and true axioms of the sport ... mixed with cutting edge strategy and an appreciation for the calculated risk.

During his time, OU has produced recordsetting passers and receivers, three 1,000-yard rushers, suffocating defense and special teams units that rank among the most dynamic in the land. Every facet has been impacted.

His players have snagged 16 national awards, including the 2003 Heisman Trophy won by Jason White. There have been 58 aca-

demic honorees, 53 All-Big 12 players, 22 All-Americans and 32 NFL draft choices.

Stoops has won a total of 10 national coach of the year awards and has been consensus Big 12 Coach of the year in three times.

The son of a coach, Stoops was a four-year starter at lowa. He began his coaching career in 1983 as a volunteer in the Hawkeye program under Hayden Fry. He worked through the ranks until he became co-defensive coordinator at

sive coordinator a Kansas State (1991-95) during Bill Snyders rein

With the Wildcats, he played a key role in an impressive turnaround. During his final four seasons there, K-State was 35-12 with three bowl appearances. Eventually, he left for Florida and a three-year stint as Steve Spurrier's defensive coordinator. In 1996, he was part of a national championship team. It was with the Gators that the spotlight found Stoops and made him one of the hottest names in the profession.

Stoops, who was born Sept. 9, 1960, in Youngstown, Ohio, graduated from lowa in 1983 with a degree in marketing. He and his wife, Carol, have three children: daughter, Mackenzie, and twin sons, Drake and Isaac.

Norman, Okla. -- DeMarco Murray scored four touchdowns, including two on dazzling runs, and Oklahoma overpowered Baylor, 52-21. It was the 17th win against no defeats for OU in the series.

Murray's first touchdown, a 25-yard scamper, made all the highlights as he weaved through and juked much of the Bears' defense. Later, he added an equally impressive 91-yard kickoff return for TD.

At the same time, QB Sam Bradford was on fire, completing 20-of-25 passes for 353 yards and three touchdowns with one interception. He was particuarly good with the long ball, completing throws of 60, 51, 43 and 42 yards during the game.

Manuel Johnson snagged four passes for 126 yards and two touchdowns. Baylor's offense was impressive, piling up 450 total yards, with 280 through the air and 170 on the ground. The Bears filed twice to score in the red zone.
